

## Compliance Gate Platform: Monthly Review Methodology (EU)

We review official web page sources each month to determine if we need to make changes to the compliance requirements list entries and/or the templates.

The review is limited to the items listed in the tables, and we do not keep track of news/updates announced elsewhere (e.g. not announced in the linked pages).

Further, we only cover and track updates related to the listed items (see tables). Regulations, directives, or standards not mentioned in this document are **not covered** by the platform, or monitored.

## Step 1: Compliance Requirements Lists

**1.1:** We manually review the EU Official Journal - Legislation ([Link](#)). We normally report the following:

<b>A</b>	Regulations, Directives, and Decisions amending a covered regulation or directive
<b>B</b>	Regulations, Directives, and Decisions amending standards harmonised under a covered regulation or directive
<b>C</b>	Corrigendum correcting a covered regulation or directive
<b>D</b>	Recommendations concerning a covered regulation or directive
<b>E</b>	New Regulations and Directives (if we deem them relevant for the product categories that we cover).

**Note:** We may also report Regulations, Directives, and Decisions related to a covered Regulation or Directive, if we deem it relevant.

**1.2** We also have **filters** setup that allow us to create a summary of EU Official Journal - Legislation updates for the regulations and directives that we monitor. We then do a 2nd review of EU Official Journal - Legislation to reduce the risk of missing relevant news.

**Not monitored:** Some regulations, standards, and requirements included in the compliance requirements lists are not actively monitored or updated.

## Source Versions

### CRL Source Example

2. Created/Updated: 2024-08-20 (sources may have been updated since this date).

#### Sources - Explainer

The sources that the entry/summary is based on are listed.

#### Note - Explainer

1. This is the **source version** that the CRL entry/summary is based on (normally the legislation version available at the time of writing).
2. **Created/Updated** is changed in the following cases:
  - a. Amendment resulting in what we deem to be a **substantial change** of covered requirements
  - b. General improvements based on information in the sources (e.g. not link redirect or UI edits alone)

### 1: New CRL entry (includes rewritten CRL entries)



Based on the **legislation version** available at the time of writing.

**Source version:** The basis for the CRL entry does not change unless it is completely rewritten based on a future version of the legislation.

### 2: Regulation amendment/update (e.g. EU OJ or Federal Register)



We assess if the amendment results in what we deem to be a **substantial change**

**If yes:** Update the CRL entry

1. The **source version** of the CRL entry remains unchanged
2. The **Created/Updated** date is updated

**If no:** No action

### 3. New regulation version published (e.g. EUR Lex or eCFR)



a. CRL entry is **not updated** (only based on amendments which tend to be announced prior to EUR Lex or eCFR updates).

b. CRL Overview > Latest Source Version is updated

1. We check the sources versions **monthly**.
2. If a new version is available, we specify this in the CRL Overview. The purpose is to help you **keep track** of the latest source versions.

### 4. Other CRL entry edits



We may also edit parts of a CRL entry for the following reasons:

- a. General improvements
- b. UI changes
- c. Source link updates (e.g. redirects).

#### Changes

1. The **source version** of the CRL entry remains unchanged
2. The **Created/Updated** date is only updated if the change is based on information in the sources (e.g. not link redirect or UI edits alone)

### 5. CRL entry is phased out



We phase out CRL entries in the following scenarios:

- a. Legislation repealed
  - b. Module or CRL entry removal
- Example:** GPSR replaced GPSD in Dec 2024.

## Step 2: Templates

**2.1:** We compare the templates to the specified source on a monthly basis.

**2.2:** We update the template if the template items and/or source versions have changed.

### Source Version

#### Template Source Example

- This template is based on the legal act (more recent versions may be available).
- Created/Updated: 2024-08-07 (sources may have been updated since this date).

#### Source - Explainer

This specifies the legislation and the part of the legislation that the template is based on.

#### Note - Explainer

- This is the **source version** that the template is based on
  - Initially the legislation version available at the time of writing
  - Updated if there is a change in the legislation version (Point 3)
- Created/Updated is changed in the following cases:
  - New source version (template items need update)
  - New source version (template items do not need update)
  - General improvements based on information in the sources (e.g. not link redirect or UI edits alone)

#### 1: New Template



Based on the **legislation version** available at the time of writing.

#### 2: Regulation amendment/update (e.g. EU OJ or Federal Register)



We **do not** update templates based on amendments

#### 3. New regulation version published (e.g. EUR Lex, eCFR or guidance page)



**Checked monthly:** We review the relevant annex/article/part/page to determine if the new version is matching or not matching the existing template

**Matching** > No template update > 1. Template source version update (matching latest version) > 2. Created/Updated/Reviewed date updated

**Not matching** > Update template items > 1. Template source version update > 2. Created/Updated/Reviewed date updated

**Note:** Template overview is updated monthly

#### 4. Other template edits



We may also edit templates for the following reasons:

- General improvements
- UI updates
- Source link updates (e.g. redirects).

#### Source version

- The basis of the template remains unchanged
- Created/Updated/Reviewed date is only updated if the change is based on information in the sources (e.g. not link redirect or UI edits alone)

#### 5. Template is phased out



We phase out templates in the following scenarios:

- Legislation repealed
  - Template, module or CRL entry removal
- Example:** GPSR replaced GPSD in Dec 2024.

### Step 3: Other monitored sources

**3.1:** We monitor the News from the ECHA in order to see if any chemical was added to the Candidate List. We normally report the following:

- Chemicals added to the Candidate List

**3.2:** If any chemical was added to the Candidate List, we report the news on the Monthly Report. We do not report other news.

## Step 4: Compliance Gate Platform testing

### Compliance Requirements List

The purpose of this test is to verify if all selected entries (country, product categories, and specifications) appear correctly in the compliance requirements lists:

**4.1:** We create a compliance requirements list with the following modules:

- Electronics
- Batteries
- Product Packaging

**4.2:** We select “Yes” for all specifications

**4.3:** We check that all entries appear on the product page

**4.4:** We check that all entries appear on the PDF report

### Templates

**4.5:** We confirm that the items in every template that is available in the Compliance Gate Platform match the items in the corresponding regulation. These items are also listed in the column “Source text” of the [EU Templates Overview](#).

**4.6:** We create a document file (PDF) for every template that is available in the Compliance Gate Platform.

**4.7:** We confirm that the items in the downloaded PDF match the items in the corresponding regulation.

## Step 5: Source link monitoring

**5.1:** All source links that can be found inside compliance requirements list entries/items and templates are available on a specific table of the Compliance Gate Platform database.

**5.2:** A copy of the table is uploaded on a separate website.

**5.3:** The links are scanned by a plugin titled Broken Link Checker. This plugin provides a list of:

- 404: Broken URLs (page removed)
- 301/302/307: Redirected URLs

**5.4:** We take the following action in case any of the above is detected:

- 404: We replace the source link
- 301/302/307: We assess if the new page is relevant\*

\*If yes, then we update to the current (redirected) source link. If not, then we replace the source link.

**5.5:** There are some scenarios in which a missing, incorrect, or irrelevant source link could be present in the compliance requirements list entries or templates:

- Plugin fails to detect 404/301/302/307
- Content changed on page (but no 404/301/302/307)

There is also a risk of human error, resulting in missing, incorrect, or irrelevant source links not being replaced.
